All items in this file were found in early 2005 by Bro Donald MacDonald in a metal filing cabinet in the Salesian Archive (then) in Stockport. Some were loose, but most were in envelopes and they had at some time been sorted and listed on the front of the envelopes. However, over time, some photos had been removed, misplaced or taken out and not returned correctly. Some envelopes contained negatives which had also been scanned earlier. Copies of many of the photos are held elsewhere but all photographs found here were scanned to make this file a complete record of what was found in the filing cabinet.
